COVID-19 PANDEMIC SAFETY GUIDELINES & PROTOCOLS

ADC PHASE 4

GENERAL POLICIES

- Class Sizes may be reduced and/or have staggered times
- We have very limited "in studio" office hours so please call/email any transactions.
- Make-ups have been temporarily suspended
- There will temporarily be no locker rooms/cubbies or lobby for viewing,
- No food allowed in the building

FACILITY

- The facility will be disinfected under CDC recommendations. All surfaces will be disinfected/sanitized multiple times throughout normal business hours.
- 6 foot social distancing markers will be labeled in ALL studios for ALL classes.
- ONLY enrolled children are allowed in the building unless under the age of (1)
- People sick or at risk are asked NOT to enter the building

HYGIENE

- Everyone entering the building is REQUIRED to wear a mask or face covering, once dancers are physically distanced in their studios for class, they may remove it. All other persons will wear face coverings in common areas while passing through.
- Dancers are to wash hands before, after & during any bathroom breaks while in the building. We also have numerous sanitizing stations throughout the facility. All dancers are also encouraged to have their own sanitizer in their bags.

ENTERING/DROP OFF/EXITING/PICK-UP

- We will NOW utilize more of our entry doors, we will ENTER from the south parking lot door and EXIT from the Sparkle (Retail) Door. ONLY arrive (5) min before enrolled class time, the door will NOT be opened early than that.
- Parents please screen your child for any illness, if the dancer is displaying any signs of illness, PLEASE stay home. If any dancers exhibit any signs of illness while at the studio they WILL be sent home. If anyone in your household is experiencing any symptoms, PLEASE stay home.
- Dancers will be dismissed by staff, one at a time through the EXIT door and to the parent/guardian.

STAFF PROTOCOL

- All staff will receive a health screening before entering the facility. Any staff exhibiting any signs of illness will be sent home. Staff will ONLY return to work when they have followed CDC and IL state protocols before returning to work.
- Staff WILL be required to wear a face covering in all common areas, during necessary help to a small child or if they CANNOT stay within (6) feet.
- Staff will wash/sanitize hands numerous times before/during/after practices throughout their shift.
- Staff going out of town to an area of quarantine will be asked to remain at home until the period of (14) days is up.
- Staff WILL be trained on ALL safety guidelines and will be prepared to ENFORCE Protocols.
